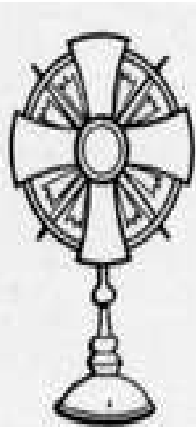


**Week of Prayer for

Awhile With Fr. Grile

Dear Parishioners,

It is good to be back with you. I thank you for your prayers for us Redemptorists as we gathered for our electoral convocation. Happily I was not elected to our Ordinary Provincial Council. This would have demanded that I move to Denver. I was elected to our Extraordinary Provincial Council. There are four elected members plus the three ordinary council members who comprise the Extraordinary Council. We meet as a council four times a year. This will occasion my being gone from the parish for four or five days every three months. There will be other demands on my time as part of this office but I think they can be managed.

This coming Friday, February 1st, is First Friday. We will have adoration of the Blessed Sacrament in the Adoration Chapel from 12:45pm (after the 12:10pm Mass) until 8:00pm. We need people to sign up for a half-hour or hour time slot so that there is always someone praying before the Blessed Sacrament. I hope the extended time of adoration will provide an opportunity for those who work during the day to have some time for prayer in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament.

February 6th is Ash Wednesday and the beginning of Lent. A prayerful and faith-filled season. We will have Mass at 8:00am on the weekdays of Lent plus the regular 12:10pm Mass. There will be Stations of the Cross on Fridays after the 12:10pm Mass and in the evening at 6:30pm. There will be a soup supper following the evening Stations of the Cross. On Wednesdays of Lent there will be a "Lenten Course" at 11:00am and at 7:00pm. There will be more details about these items in next weeks bulletin. Lent is a journey. How do you make that journey?
