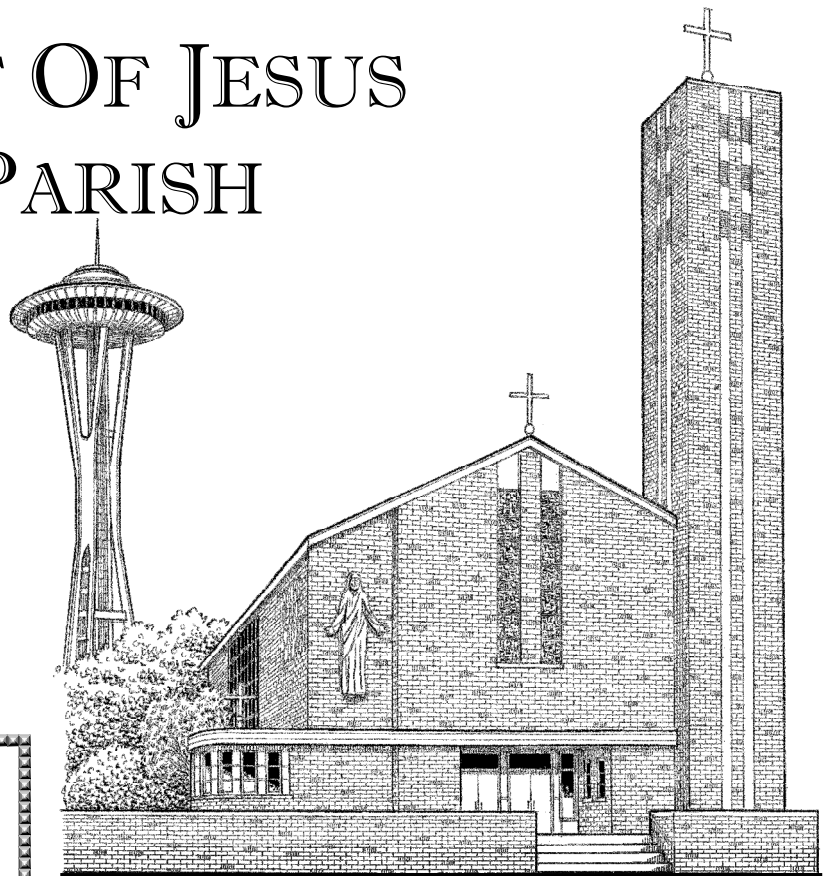

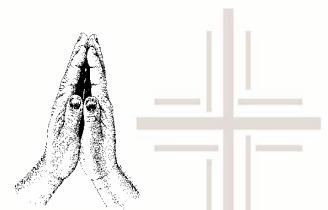

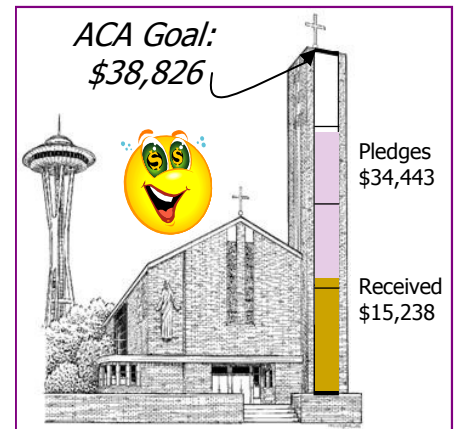

University of Washington

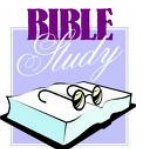
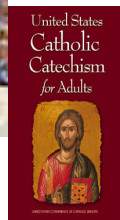
