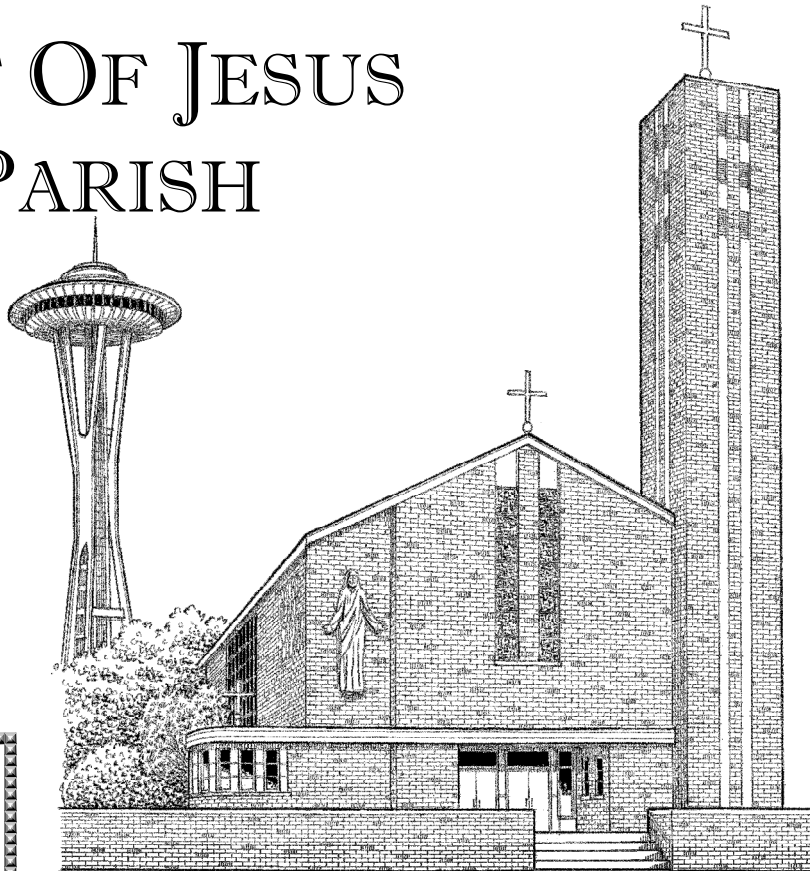

A fitting way to mark the day is to celebrate Mass. We will have Mass at 9:00am on Monday, May 26th.

We will use the readings from the feast of the Sacred Heart and this will give us a chance to reflect on the richness of this telling symbol of God's love for us. Our soon-to-be neighbors, First United Methodist Church, will be starting their Sunday breakfast for the homeless on June 22nd. 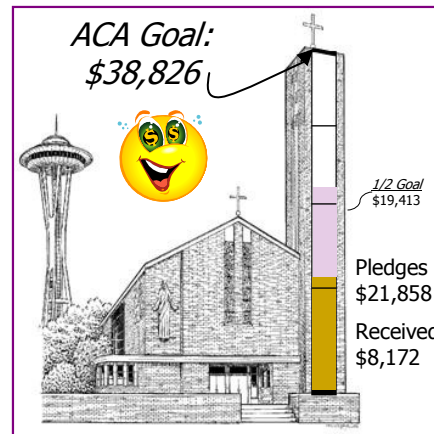
