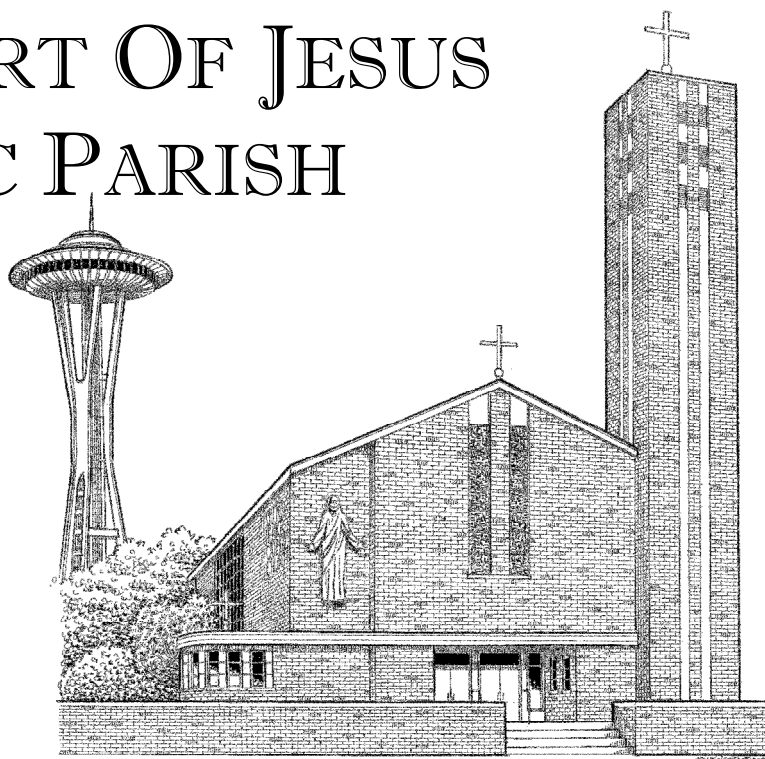

Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we welcome two different choirs from Vancouver, B.C. who will be joining us at our 9:00am and 11:00am Masses on Sunday. They will each sing a couple songs during the liturgy. They will also be performing at the Italian Festival on Sunday at the Seattle Center.

We welcome many visitors here at Sacred Heart and I'm grateful that parishioners make our visitors feel welcomed. This is especially true of the greeters at the Masses where we have greeters. This is one of the ministries that I would like to see grow in the months ahead.

For the past several months the Parish Pastoral Council has been meeting. We have developed a mission statement that you find on the cover of the bulletin. The last several meetings we have also been working on goals and objectives along with some action plans to attain those goals. One of the action plans is to establish a Worship/Liturgy Committee. I think it is important that we have a Liturgy Committee. If you have a desire to serve on such a committee, please give me or Fr. Joe a call. A couple sub-committees from that group will be a Greeters Committee and an Art and Environment Committee.

Another action plan approved by the council is to have a parish mission in Lent of '09. I have contacted one of our Redemptorists to preach the mission and we will



determine the date very soon. We will need a committee to work on preparing and publicizing the mission. So there are lots of opportunities for some short as well as longer commitments to help in the parish.

The Parish Finance Council has also been meeting regularly. They are keeping careful watch on both income and expenditures. The Stewardship Commission is also meeting regularly and have some good plans in place for the coming year. We have a small Facilities Committee and that group could use a couple more people. Contact Larry Pomada at the church office if you feel called to serve on that committee.

Next weekend we will be asking parishioners to fill out a census form after Mass. We will take a few minutes at "announcement time" to fill out basic information. This is an effort to have accurate records so we can better communicate with all those who call Sacred Heart their parish.

God continue and guide the good work that He has begun in us.
