

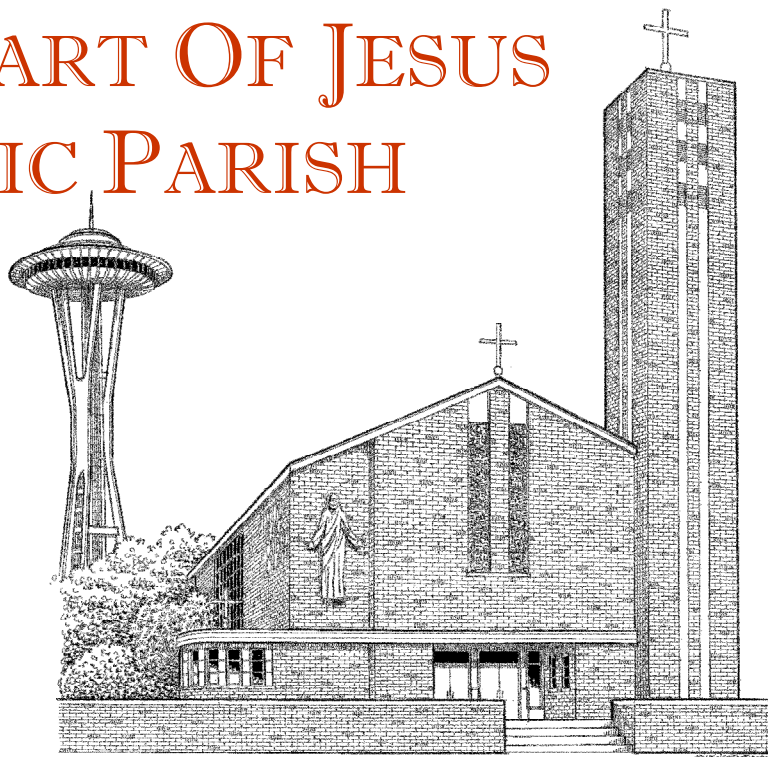

Dear Parishioners,

Lent is upon us. Wednesday is Ash Wednesday and the beginning of Lent. We will have Mass and the distribution of ashes at 8:00am, 12:10pm, and 7:00pm. Ash Wednesday is also a day of fast and abstinence.

There will be Stations of the Cross prayed each Friday of Lent at 12:40pm (following the 12:10pm Mass) and at 6:30pm. In the past we have had a soup supper following the 6:30pm Mass. This year I failed to organize people or groups to do the soup suppers. Is there anyone who would like to take on this task of organizing a soup supper following Stations? I think it is rather late to try to have something this coming Friday. We could begin on Friday, March 6th.

In the past the pastor of Sacred Heart Parish offered Lenten Stepping Stones as a spiritual pathway to Holy Week and Easter. I suggest we do "stepping stones" in the following way, a different stone for each week.

Lent week 1: Attend the Parish Mission, March 1-5.

Lent week 2: Spend five minutes in silent prayer each day.

Lent week 3: Attend Mass at least once during the week or make a visit to the Blessed Sacrament

Lent week 4: Pray the Stations of the Cross once this week.

Lent week 5: Do something uplifting for someone in need.

Lent week 6: Attend at least one Holy Week service on Holy Thursday, Good Friday, or the Easter Vigil.

The practices of weeks 2-5 can be done every week but if we focus on one particular practice we have a better chance to do it that week. The goal of these and any Lenten practices or observances is to help us renew the life of Christ within us. This great gift of life was given to us at our baptism.

Our parish mission, "Believe the Good News," begins next Sunday, March 1st, at 7:00pm and continues each evening at 7:00pm through Thursday, March 5th. Do plan to attend. It is a time to renew the fire of God's love within us or rekindle that fire if it has gone out. Invite a friend or neighbor to come with you. If you cannot come every evening, come as often as your schedule allows.

People have volunteered to be greeters and ministers during the mission as well as to provide for the social following each evening service. We may need some help with the socials. Could you provide some cookies or "bars" for Tuesday and Wednesday evenings? There will be a sign-up sheet in the vestibule of the church.

Pray, pray for the success of the mission. Happy Lent!

Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of the Season of Lent. It is a season of penance, reflection, and fasting which prepares us for Christ's Resurrection. Our foreheads are marked with ashes to humble our hearts. We remember this when we are told "Remember, You are dust, and unto dust you shall return." Ashes are a symbol of penance made sacramental by the blessing of the Church. The ashes are made from the blessed palms used in the Palm Sunday celebration of the previous year. The ashes are christened with Holy Water and are scented by exposure to incense. While the ashes symbolize penance and contrition, they are also a reminder that God is gracious and merciful to those who call on Him with repentant hearts.
