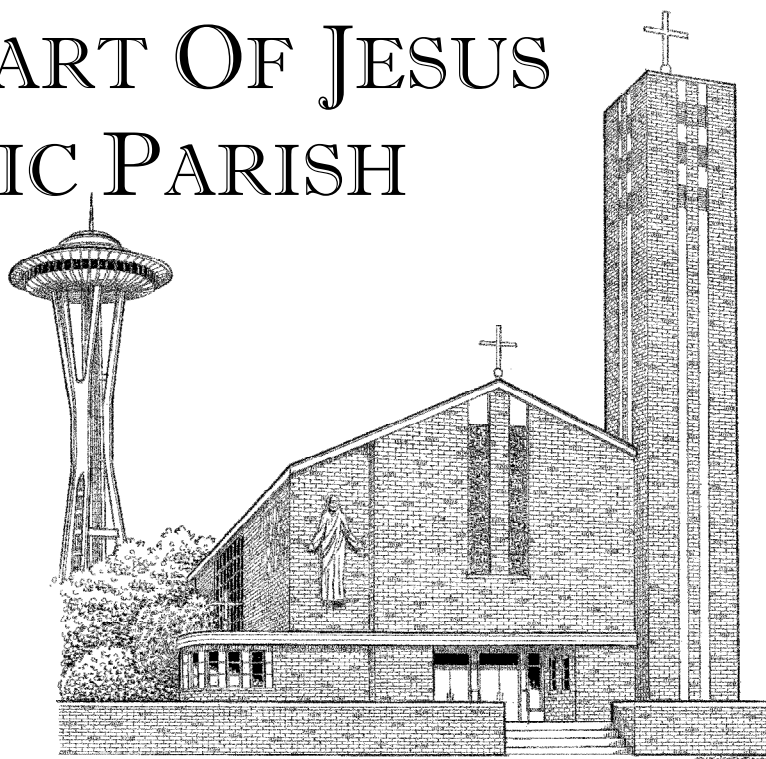

Dear Parishioners,

Happy New Year! To all those who will be celebrating the Lunar New Year we wish many blessings. Fr. Joe Ngo is away this weekend taking a delayed Christmas break. He timed it so he could be with his family in Austin, Texas and celebrate the New Year. Then, when he comes back he has a two-day workshop with other “recently” ordained priests as part of the transition to ministry program here in the Archdiocese.

This Wednesday and Thursday (January 28-29) Fr. Dick Mevissen, who is Vicar to the Provincial of our Redemptorist Province, will be visiting our Redemptorist community. This is a friendly once-a-year visit to see how our community is doing. We welcome Fr. Mevissen.

A few words from Archbishop Brunett about the Freedom of Choice Act (FOCA):

“As disciples of Christ, we are called to advocate for the life and dignity of each human being, especially the poor and vulnerable... The proponents of abortion are preparing to reintroduce the Freedom of Choice Act (FOCA) in the new Congress, which has begun meeting this month. FOCA would overturn hundreds of current laws on conscience rights, informed consent, limits on tax-funded abortion, and parental involvement in minors’ abortion decisions. The Archdiocese of Seattle is participating in the **Fight FOCA Campaign**, sponsored by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops.” There will be material available this weekend to help us express our opposition to FOCA.

The Archbishop continues: “We are being confronted by those who think human freedom means the ‘right’ to have abortions and assisted suicide. We must continue to be strong in our advocacy for human dignity and life, especially on behalf of the least among us: the unborn and the dying. I am grateful for all the ways that you uphold and extend the principles of our Faith.”

The theme for our parish mission, March 1-5, is “Believe the Good News!” We will have a service each evening of the Mission at 7:00pm. Keep your calendars clear for that week, the first full week of Lent.

Happy New Year and many blessings for the year. Pray for Christian unity.

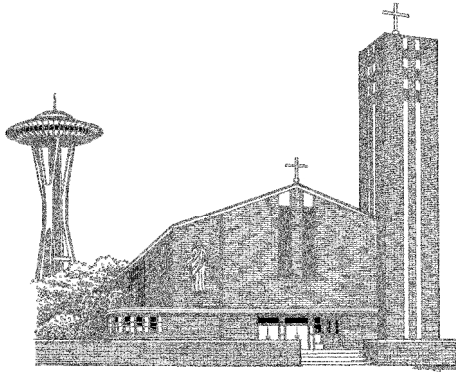
