Dear Parishioners,

Thanks to all those who brought “something” and all those who shared that “something” last Sunday after the 11:00am Mass. We had a good gathering at the pot-luck. There was plenty of good food and good conversation. It was a real “taste of Sacred Heart.”

June and early July are the months of anniversaries for many of us priests. Fr. Joe Ngo celebrated two years (2007) on June 16th. Us old guys are as follows: Fr. Lyle Konen (48 years) June 29, 1961; Fr. Bill Cleary, July 2, 1962; Fr. Ray Maiser, July 2, 1964 (50 years as a Redemptorist, August 2nd); Fr. Bill Peterson, July 1, 1967; and myself, June 27, 1968. So lots of years of priestly service in this little group of Redemptorists. And Brother Paul Jorns will have forty years as a Redemptorist this August 2nd as he took first vows in 1969.

In talking with the Parish Finance Council and the Parish Pastoral Council, I have decided to start a second collection on the first Sunday of each month to help with the increased utility bills for the church. Noel House (the women’s shelter in the basement of the church) put all their allocated money into fixing up the space and this was in lieu of paying rent. So we the parish have to pay the extra utilities costs. So a few extra dollars from parishioners and visitors will go a long way in helping to pay for the church utilities bills. We’ll do this for as long as Noel House is here at Sacred Heart. It is another way that we can support our outreach to the homeless.

Last Sunday we were “boxed” in here at the parish from 7:00-9:30am. We were not aware of the street blockage until Thursday, June 18th, and so it was too late to warn parishioners trying to make it to the 9:00am Mass. We registered a complaint with both the Seattle Center and the City, which gave the permits for the street closures. Hopefully this will not happen again. Thanks to all who were so patient with our late start of the 9:00am Mass.

Thanks for all who were generous in the second collection last weekend for Peter’s Pence. The collection was \$1,644.

And the Holy Father also thanks you.

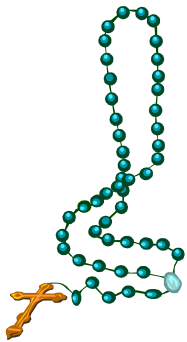
