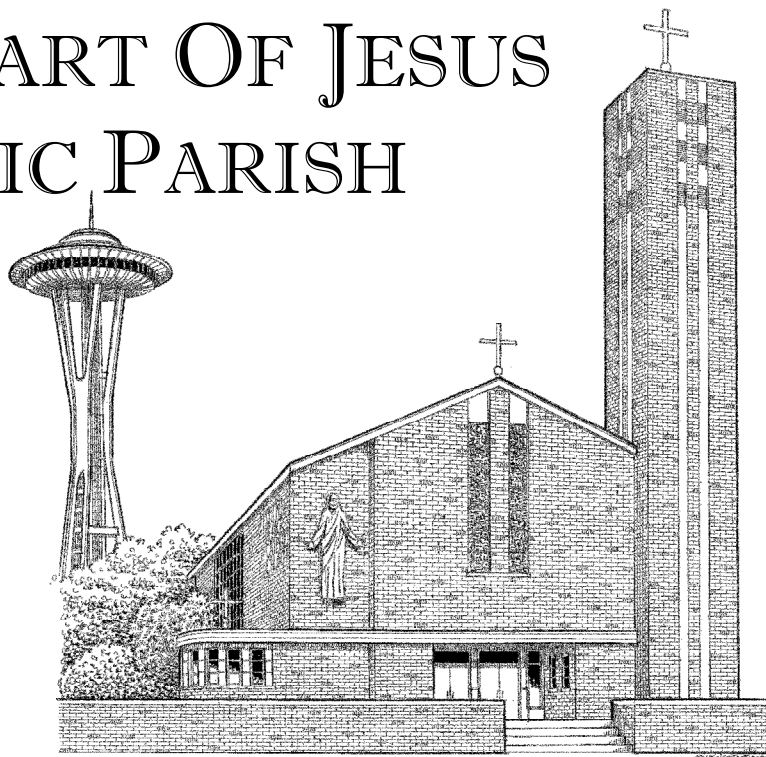

Dear Parishioners,

If all goes well we should have the parish needs analysis survey available for pickup this weekend. The needs analysis survey is a tool to help me and the parish leadership find out what the parish needs are. Then we can plan on how to meet those needs. The survey will be placed in an envelope with your name on it and can be picked up in the vestibule of the church. It will take about ten minutes to fill out. The survey is for all our registered parishioners. If you are a parishioner and do not find an envelope with your name on it, there will be extra forms for people to take home. There is also a way to complete the survey

The work on the church basement is just about completed. The parish will be hosting Noel House, which is a women's overnight shelter, for a year beginning April 20th. Noel House comes under the Archdiocesan Housing Authority and they have finished off the eastern part of the church basement so it can be used for a temporary shelter. When the shelter moves out we will have a good start to making that portion of the basement into a larger meeting space for parish use. Sacred Heart Parish is once again responding to the needs of the poor and homeless and we can be grateful that God has blessed us with facilities to do that. Thanks also to a parishioner who paid for the laying of cement in that area of the church basement as well as providing carpet for the area.

Next Sunday is Palm Sunday and the beginning of Holy Week. Please note the time of services for Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Easter Vigil (all at 7:00pm). In preparation for Easter there will be a "church cleaning party" on Wednesday, April 8th at 1:00pm (following the 12:10pm Mass). We'll supply the cleaning stuff if you supply the hands. We especially need to clean the pews and sanctuary part of the church. Then on Saturday, April 11, (Holy Saturday) we need volunteers to help decorate the church for Easter. "The decorating party" will begin at 10:30am in the church.

Note that Wednesday, April 8th, will be the last opportunity for confessions before Easter. We will hear confessions before the 8:00am and 12:10pm Masses on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday of Holy Week and before the 5:30pm Mass on Tuesday. There will not be confession time on Holy Saturday.

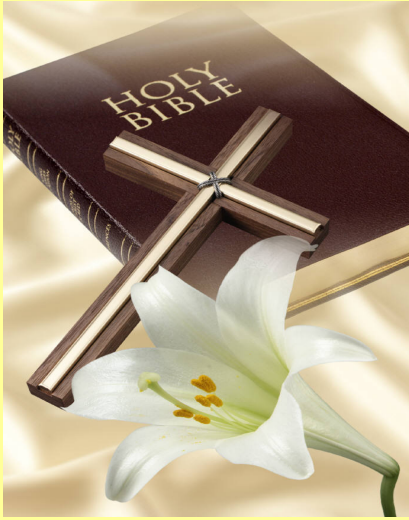
