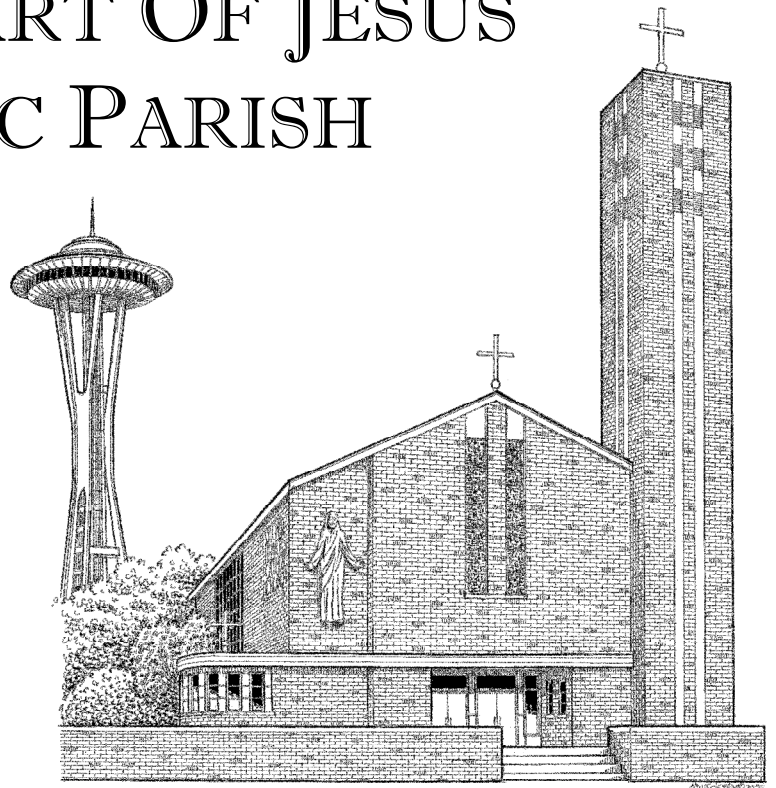

Dear Parishioners,

In two weeks we will have a very special celebration here at Sacred Heart. On Saturday, June 13th Patrick O'Hogan, who was music director here at Sacred Heart, will be ordained a priest for the Archdiocese of Seattle. On Sunday, June 14th at 11:00am Patrick will celebrate a Mass of Thanksgiving here at Sacred Heart. You are all invited to this grateful celebration. Patrick calls Sacred Heart his "home parish." We wish him well in his ministry as a priest in the Archdiocese.

Next weekend Fr. Allan Weinert, C.Ss.R. will be here to speak at all the Masses on our Co-Redemptorist Association. This is a way for you to join us in supporting future Redemptorists in religious life and the priesthood. I know you will give him a warm welcome. Fr. Allan is presently serving in our provincial government as finance officer for our Denver Province.

Some very good [news](#): We are at 94% toward our goal of \$43,000 for the Annual Catholic Appeal. That is very good news. If you have not returned your pledge envelope I ask that you do that very soon. Anything above the goal that is collected will be returned to the parish. I have designated any excess funds to be used to help finish off the unfinished part of the basement that is presently being used by Noel House. We will need to finish walling off the east side of the room as well as installing better lighting so we can use it for a parish hall or gathering space.

Some bad [news](#): The sewage line from Sacred Heart Shelter (the old convent building) became blocked with roots from somewhere and it demanded major digging to get at the source of the trouble. This is one of those unforeseen problems that will put a big demand on our finances. We'll know more when we finish the bids and they begin the work.

On Friday, June 19th we will be hosting a newcomers dinner here at the rectory. If you are recently registered in the parish you should have received an invitation to the dinner. If you are recently registered and were not able to attend the dinner we had in October last year, call the office and let them know you would like to attend this one. Space is somewhat limited so call this week.

I will be "out of the office" this week attending a Provincial Council meeting in Denver. Pray for us as we wrestle with the budget for the coming year. Lots of demands for funds and a dwindling source to generate those funds. Fr. Joe and my Redemptorist confreres will be holding down the fort.

SACRED HEART SHELTER
CHILDREN'S PROGRAM VOLUNTEER

Join a team of volunteers to work with children in a structured setting. Help create a fun safe environment for children to build healthy relationships and explore ideas and feelings about themselves and others through organized play and structured activities.

The qualifications are a desire to interact positively with homeless families, a willingness to work with children who may have developmental or behavioral challenges and you must pass a Washington State Patrol background check.

Time parameters will be agreed upon by the volunteer and the volunteer coordinator. Usually the commitment is one and one half hour shifts once a week for six months. Please call the volunteer coordinator at Sacred Heart Seattle at 206-285-7489.

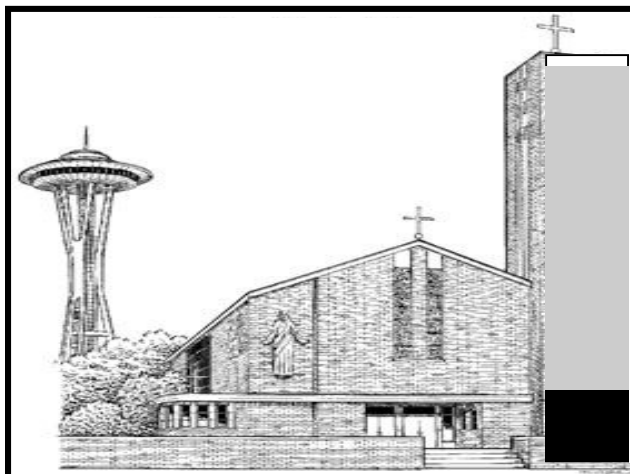
