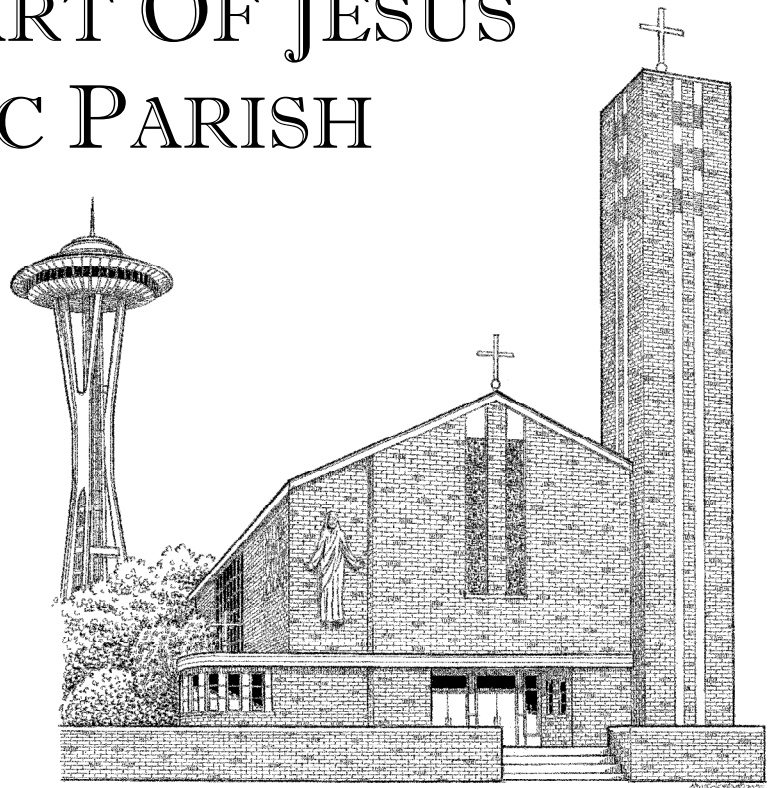
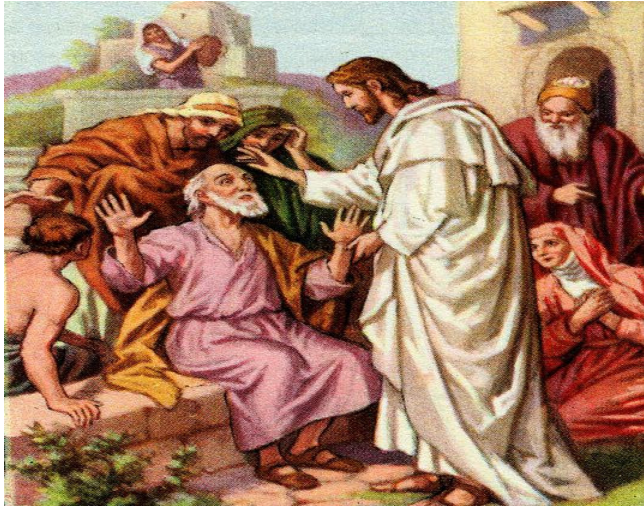

This past June 19<sup>th</sup> on the feast of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, Pope Benedict XVI inaugurated the Year for Priests. 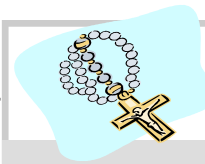
